



**Full Course of Study Requirement**

A full course of study for a student non-degree is defined as "an academic program with a specific educational objective. Such course of study may include intensive English language training, classroom instruction, research projects, and/or Academic Training" and must consist of a minimum of 18 hours of engagement per week if the student is engaged primarily in classroom instruction and 22 hours per week if the student is engaged primarily in research. This engagement cannot include employment by the University of Kentucky. Any employment must be in addition to the 18 hours.

Please complete the below segment(s) to show that a full course of study is planned for the student non-degree. Use a new line for each different activity. If engaged in coursework, use a new line for each course. If the activities change significantly (ex. the student may begin their program by observing courses, but end the program doing research, the student may change courses every semester, or the student may work in a new lab or with a different professor) use a new segment to indicate these changes. Also use a new segment to indicate a major break from programming (ex. the student has a summer break). A student's program cannot end on a major break. Each segment must indicate at least 18 hours of engagement per week except during major breaks, and must cover the entirety of the period of the DS-2019.
